ASBESTOS INITIAL TRAINING

Asbestos Maintenance Worker Initial \$315

- Also known as Class III or O & M Training (Operations & Maintenance)
- **Who Needs this Training?** Maintenance/custodial staff, electricians, HVAC technicians, plumbers, etc.), who may work in a building public or commercial, or a school that contains asbestos.
- In this 2-day course workers will cover regulations regarding this type of limited asbestos-related work, history, & uses of asbestos materials in buildings, potential health effects, personal protection, engineering controls & response actions, & methodologies for abatement & disturbance during routine maintenance activities.
- **Regulations:** 40 CFR 763.92(a)(1)-(2), 40 CFR 61, 8 CCR 1529

NOV 19-20 DEC 17-18

Asbestos Worker Initial \$495

- **Who Needs this Training?** Maintenance/custodial staff, electricians, HVAC technicians, plumbers, etc.), abatement laborers.
- This four-day course is accredited and covers many topics including safety, laws and regulations, and state-of-the-art work procedures. The participant will also be involved in hands-on training which will include activities such as donning personal protective equipment, building a decontamination unit, glove-bagging, and proper use of common asbestos abatement equipment and tools. Prerequisites: None
- **Regulations:** 40 CFR 763, 8 CCR 1529, 40 CFR 61, 40 CFR Appendix C to Subpart E

SEP 24-27

ASBESTOS INITIAL TRAINING

Asbestos Contractor/Supervisor Initial \$695

- Required for CAC & CSST Certifications
- **Who Needs this Training?** Supervisors & Competent Persons who will engage in the work or will be directly responsible for the overall supervision of employees in relation to its asbestos abatement activities.
- This course will cover how to perform abatement activities for a response action other than a SSSD activity, a maintenance activity that disturbs friable asbestos other than a SSSD activity & a response action for a major fiber release episode.
- **Regulations:** 40 CFR 763, 8 CCR 1529, 40 CFR 61, 40 CFR Appendix C to Subpart E

SEP 24-28 OCT 22-26 DEC 17-21

Asbestos Project Designer Initial \$600

- Required for CAC Certification
- **Who Needs this Training?** Any person who intends to design any of the following activities with respect to friable ACBM in a school or public and commercial building: 1) a response action other than a SSSD maintenance activity, 2) a maintenance activity that disturbs friable ACBM other than a SSSD maintenance activity and/or 3) a response action for a major fiber release episode.
- This course includes lectures, demonstrations, a field trip, course review and a written examination.
- **Regulations:** 40 CFR 763, 8 CCR 1529, 40 CFR 61, 40 CFR Appendix C to Subpart E

DEC 10-12

ASBESTOS INITIAL TRAINING

Asbestos Building Inspector Initial \$550*

- Required for CAC & CSST Certifications
- **Who Needs this Training?** All persons who want to be able to inspect for Asbestos Containing Building Materials (ACBMs) in schools or public and commercial buildings.
- The course is focused on lectures and hands-on training conducting a simulated sample collection and inspection, and includes respirator and other personal protective equipment use.
- **Regulations:** 40 CFR 763, 8 CCR 1529, 40 CFR 61, 40 CFR Appendix C to Subpart E

AUG 27-29 SEP 17-19 OCT 1-3

Asbestos Management Planner Initial \$330*

- Required for CAC Certification
- **Who Needs this Training?** All persons who prepare management plans for schools must be accredited and take this course.
- Persons seeking accreditation as a Management Planner shall first complete a 3-day Inspector training course, then a 2-day Management Planner training course.
- This course includes lectures, demonstrations, course review, and a written examination.
- **Regulations:** 40 CFR 763, 8 CCR 1529, 40 CFR 61, 40 CFR Appendix C to Subpart E

 - This course is for employees who may work in a building (public/commercial or school) that contains asbestos.
 - Requires at least two (2) hours, whether or not they are required to work with the asbestos.
 - Regulations:** 40 CFR 763.92(a)(1)(i)-(v) & 8 CCR 1529(k)(9)(H)

LEAD INITIAL TRAINING

- Lead Sampling Technician \$250 (8 hrs)**
 - Requires Annual Certification Fee to CDPH.
 - This course covers the background on health risks of lead; how to conduct a visual assessment & examination; how to collect dust wipe, paint chip, and soil samples plus an overview of how to use an XRF analyzer.

AUG 31	SEP 19	OCT 15	DEC 7
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- Lead Worker Initial \$425 (24 hrs)**
 - Requires Annual Certification Fee to CDPH.
 - This 3-day CDPH course includes: introduction to the history of lead, how lead is used, the health effects of lead poisoning, lead regulations, hazard recognition and control, medical surveillance, medical removal, person protective measures, respirators, clothing and hygiene and work practices during abatement.

NOV 5-7	NOV 26-28
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- Lead Supervisor/Project Monitor \$599**
 - Who Needs this Training?** Superintendents, Foreman, Project Managers
 - Requires State Exam & Annual Certification Fees to become fully certified by CDPH.
 - In this course, students will learn how lead abatement is performed in a variety of settings, how to safely handle lead materials during construction projects and how to select appropriate abatement actions for varying field conditions.

SEP 10-14	NOV 12-16
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LEAD INITIAL TRAINING

Lead Inspector/Assessor \$750 (40 hrs)

- Requires State Exam & Annual Certification Fees to become fully certified by CDPH.
- In this course students study & put into practice HUD protocols for inspecting facilities for lead coatings & for assessing hazards posed by lead. Students learn about paint chip sampling and its analysis by atomic absorption, and about the principles of x-ray fluorescence (XRF) testing and use state-of-the-art XRF analyzers in the field.

NOV 5-9

Lead Awareness \$100* (2 hours)

- Who Needs this Training?** Supervisors, Construction Superintendents, Project Managers, etc.
- This course is for employees who are working in proximity to lead, but not directly with lead. The also covers general knowledge of hazards associated with lead exposure & requirements to reduce or eliminate exposure.
- Requires at least two (2) hours, whether or not they are required to work with the lead.
- Regulation:** 8CCR 1532.1, Lead Appendix B

LEAD CONTINUING EDUCATION

Lead CE Worker \$200 (7 hrs)

- Pre-requisite:** Lead Worker Initial Training (24 hours)
- Continuing Education is required every 2 years.

LEAD CONTINUING EDUCATION

Lead CE General \$200 (7 hrs)

- Pre-requisite(s):** Lead Supervisor/Project Monitor, Lead Inspector/Assessor or Lead Sampling Technician
- Continuing Education is required every 2 years for certified Lead Supervisors, Project Monitors, & Inspector/Assessors.

AUG 27 SEP 20 OCT 11 NOV 2 DEC 14

LEAD EXAM INFORMATION

Lead State Exam Prep Course \$100/\$200

- This course will help students prepare for the CDPH exam to become either a certified Lead Supervisor or Inspector/Assessor in the State of California. A review of topics will be covered, the CDPH study guide will be the outline for the course. Students will gain a better grasp of what to study for to prepare for the exam.

FEDERAL EPA LEAD RRP INITIAL

Federal EPA Lead Renovation, Repair & Painting Initial Training \$200 (8 hrs)

- Who Needs this Training?** Any contractor, including renovators, electricians, HVAC specialists, carpet installers, window installers, plumbers, painters & maintenance staff, who disrupt more than six square feet of lead paint in pre-1978 homes, schools, day care centers & other places where children spend time.
- Refresher Training Required every 5 years. There is NO Grace Period.**
- Contractors are subject to steep EPA fines if training & Firm Certification) is not met.
- EPA Firm Certification** must be completed separately from the training via the EPA website. **The cost per firm certification is \$300.**
- This course was developed to train renovation, repair, and painting contractors how to work safely in housing with lead-based paint and comply with EPA's RRP Rule, and HUD's Lead Safe Housing Rule.

SEP 4 OCT 8 NOV 1 DEC 3

FEDERAL EPA LEAD RRP REFRESHER

Federal EPA Lead Renovation, Repair & Painting Refresher Training \$125 (4 hrs)

- Required every 5 years. There is NO Grace Period.**
- Tip for Business Owners:** Apply for your Firm Certification Renewal at the same time you are completing your Refresher Training.

OCT 30 NOV 15

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HAZWOPER INITIAL TRAINING

40 hour HAZWOPER \$695

- Who Needs this Training?** This course is designed for site workers involved in the investigation, clean-up & removal of hazardous waste, & other activities which expose or potentially expose workers to hazardous substances or health hazards.
- The course features lectures to help workers learn about hazard awareness, hazardous waste regulations, exposure and medical monitoring, health and safety planning, respiratory protection, personal protective clothing, monitoring and sampling equipment, site characterization and control, decontamination, and emergency response.
- Regulation:** 8 CCR 5192(e)(3)(A)

SEP 17-21 OCT 15-19 NOV 12-16

24 hour HAZWOPER \$495

- Who Needs this Training?** Workers who are only onsite occasionally for a specific limited task (such as, but not limited to, ground water monitoring, land surveying, or geo-physical surveying) & who are unlikely to be exposed over PELs and published exposure levels.
- This course covers identification of personnel & alternates responsible for site safety & health; safety, health & practices to minimize risks from hazards; safe use of engineering controls & equipment on the site; medical surveillance requirements; and site safety and health plans, etc.
- Regulation:** 8 CCR 5192(e)(3)(B).

SEP 17-19 OCT 15-17 NOV 12-14

To convert your 24 HOUR HAZWOPER, take the 16 hour Upgrade.

HAZWOPER REFRESHER TRAINING

8 hour HAZWOPER Refresher \$200

- Refresher required **annually**.
- Pre-requisite(s):** 24 or 40 hour or HAZ FRO

SEP 5 OCT 10 NOV 5 DEC 12

OTHER HAZMAT TRAINING

HAZ FRO (8 hrs)

- Also known as HAZ First Responder Officer
- Who Needs this Training?** Designated employees who act as first responders to respond to releases or potential releases of hazardous substances.
- The course covers hazard & risk assessment techniques, use of proper PPE, basic hazardous materials terms, knowledge to perform basic control, containment, and/or confinement operations & rescue injured or contaminated persons within the capabilities of the resources and PPE available with their unit as well as an understanding of the relevant standard operating procedures & termination procedures.
- Regulation:** 29 CFR 1910.120(q)(6)(ii) and 29 CFR 1926.65(q)(6)(ii)

DOT SHIPPER (8 hrs)

- Who Needs this Training?** Employees who prepare & inspect shipments, prepare shipping papers prior
- Training focus includes general awareness, function specific activities, safety and health, security, and exercises in filling out shipping papers and selecting containers.
- Regulation:** 49 CFR 172.704

SILICA TRAINING

Crystalline Silica in Construction for Workers \$100 (2 hrs)

Crystalline Silica in Construction for Supervisors \$150 (4 hrs)

- Who Needs this Training?** Supervisors, Construction Superintendents, Project Managers, Laborers, etc.
- These courses focus on worker exposures to respirable crystalline silica and steps to protect workers. Contractors are subject to OSHA fines if training compliance is not met.
- Regulations:** 8 CCR 1532.3 & 8 CCR 1530.1

OCT 22 NOV 19

CONFINED SPACE TRAINING

Confined Space Entry (8 hrs)

- Who Needs This Training?** Manufacturing Facilities, Refineries, Wineries, Abatement/Remediation, Waste Management, Restoration, Pest Control, Underground Utility Contractors, etc.
- Topics will include recognition of confined space hazards, identification of permit & non-permit required confined spaces, use of instrumentation to evaluate atmospheric hazards, ventilation techniques, development/implementation of a confined space program, proper signage, and training requirements.
- Regulations:** 8 CCR 5157 & 29 CFR 1910.146

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OSHA FOR CONSTRUCTION

- **OSHA 10 for Construction**
 - 2-day course (cannot be held in (1) single day)
 - **Who Needs this Training?** Supervisors, Construction Superintendents, Project Managers, etc.
 - This training program is intended for entry level construction workers to inform them about their rights, employer responsibilities, how to file a complaint as well as how to identify, abate, avoid and prevent job related hazards on a construction site.
- **OSHA 30 for Construction**

OTHER SAFETY TRAINING

- **Medic First Aid/CPR Training \$75 (6 hrs)**
 - **Who Needs this Training?** Supervisors, Construction Superintendents, Project Managers, Manufacturing Plant Employees, Lifeguards, Daycare Providers, School Teachers and Administrators, etc.
 - This course is a combined adult CPR, AED, and first aid training program designed specifically for the occupational first aid provider. This extremely flexible program will help employers meet OSHA and other federal and state regulatory requirements for training employees how to respond and care for medical emergencies at work.
 - **Recognized Certification Period:** Up to 2 years
 - **Teacher to Student Ratio** is 12:1
 - Group Training Available
 - On-Site Training Available

OTHER SAFETY TRAINING

- **Respiratory Protection & Fit Testing**
 - **Who Needs this Training?** Anybody working with a respirator or supervising any employees who will be utilizing respirators on the job
 - Per 1910.134(k), requires the Employer to provide effective training to employees who are required to use respirators. The training must be comprehensive, understandable, and recur annually and more often if necessary. The employer is also required to provide the basic information on respirators in Appendix D of this section to employees who wear respirators when not required by this section or by the employer to do so.

- **Safety At Heights (Fall Protection)**
 - **Who Needs this Training?** Employers shall provide a training program for each employee who might be exposed to fall hazards. Training shall enable each employee to recognize the hazards of falling & shall train each employee to minimize these hazards.
 - This course covers the Cal/OSHA Fall Protection Standard for construction and an overview of fall protection methods. Course topics include principles of safety at heights/ fall protection, components and limitations of fall arrest systems, and OSHA Standards and policies regarding fall protection. Students will participate in workshops demonstrating the inspection and use of fall protection equipment, residential construction fall protection, training requirements, and developing a fall protection program.

MOLD TRAINING

- **Mold Inspection Training (8 hrs)**
 - **Who Needs this Training?** Restoration and environmental technicians.
 - \$450 if combined with Mold Remediation
 - This is a 1-day course, which is designed to prepare students to recognize, evaluate, investigate, sample, and interpret our #1 environmental problem affecting us today, "MOLD".

- **Mold Remediation Training (8 hrs)**
 - **Who Needs this Training?** Restoration and remediation employees who seek the skills required to perform mold remediation.
 - \$450 if combined with Mold Inspection
 - If you are an environmental and/or public health professional, take the Mold Course "Introduction to Mold Remediation for Environmental and Public Health Professionals." The prevention of mold growth is only possible if the factors causing the growth are identified, controlled, and eliminated. This 1-day course will address the causes of microbial (mold) infestation, how to recognize it, what to do about it, how to protect yourself from it, and how to remediate it. This is an 8 hour course.
